PARENT / CARER

To help keep my child and school staff as safe as possible, I confirm that I understand and will follow the following protocols:

- I will check my child for symptoms each morning, including checking their temperature;
- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school; we will get tested and self-isolate until the results are received. I will let the school know the results immediately;
- If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school **immediately**;
- When dropping my child off and picking them up, we will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules;
- **When dropping off and picking up, I will stick strictly to the school timings for my child;**
- I will teach my child the symptoms of Coronavirus so they can tell an adult if they have them ;
- **My child will bring a water bottle, a piece of fresh fruit, a waterproof coat, and nothing else, to school;**
- I understand that my child will be going outside, whatever the weather;
- My child will not take items home from school;
- I will remind my child about social distancing rules, but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child and other children may not always do this successfully;
- My child will know how to use good respiratory and hand hygiene;
- I will not be allowed into the school grounds, except to collect my child if they are sick, or to go to a pre-arranged doctor’s appointment;
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an ‘as safe as possible’ environment during this crisis;
- I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home;
- I will inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers and emergency contacts details;
- If my child is deemed unsafe, they will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe.

I will do my best to:

- Follow to the social distancing rules in class and in the playground;
- Move around school as instructed trying to maintain social distance;
- Tell an adult if I feel unwell;
- Only bring my water bottle and a coat from home

- Only enter the toilet if there is no one else in there;
- Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others;
- Not cough, spit at or sneeze towards others;
- Follow these expectations and know that if I don’t, I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.
