PE and School Sport Premium

The government in England is providing additional and substantial, ring-fenced funding to provide support to primary PE and school sport. This funding is being jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport, and will see money going directly to primary school to spend on improving the quality of physical education and sport for all their children.

Vision - Government

All pupils leaving primary school physically literate and with the knowledge, skills and motivation necessary to equip them for a healthy lifestyle and lifelong participation in physical activity and sport.

Vision - School

At George Grenville, we believe a high quality PE and games curriculum should be an integral part of the whole school curriculum and by using specialist sports coaches, our children can access the best possible training in order to develop their skills. We believe that every child deserves the same opportunities, regardless of background. We therefore make it a priority that all our pupils have an opportunity to enter sports competition, to experience being part of a team. Sport and physical education is part of the whole day and fitness breaks are encouraged. We strongly believe that fit and healthy children contribute to active and engaged learners. Due to covid, some of these opportunities may not be possible this year. We will therefore use the money to invest in enriching the PE provision in school to maximise the opportunities the children have. We will also ensure there is a greater emphasis on physical activity as a result of the recent lockdown and decreased fitness in the children as a result.
