




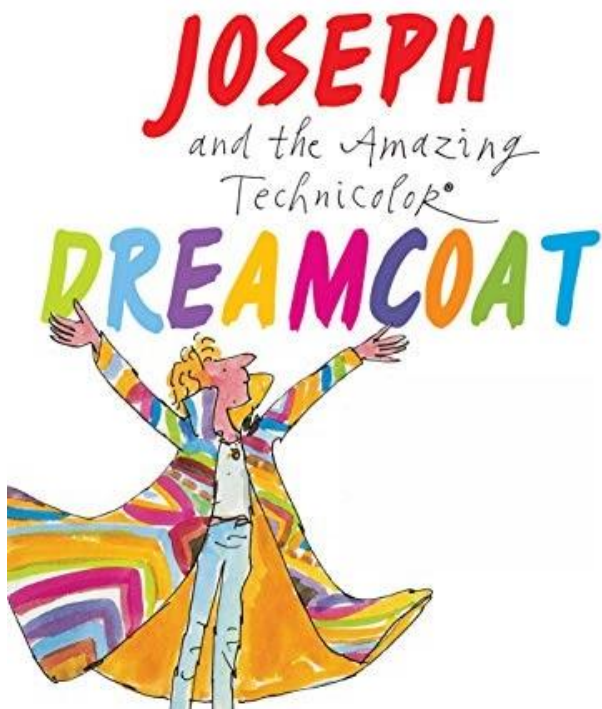

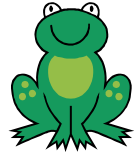

This week, Reception have been really imaginative by using resources around them to find ways of making and breaking numbers to 10. Their ideas included using doubles knowledge and even pairs of 2! They were all brilliant at explaining how they built their number and it was great to see everyone doing it differently.

This week in maths, we have been finding out about halves and quarters. Year 1 have been using purple mash to learn more about this.



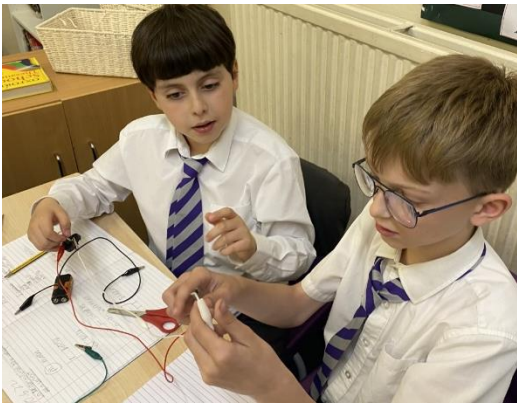
Year 2

This week, Year 3 have been learning about water transportation in plants. We put sticks of celery in cups of water with food colouring and observed the water travelling through tubes in the stalks - called xylem. We then tried to make our own xylem from straws and suck water all the way from our "roots" to our "leaves"!



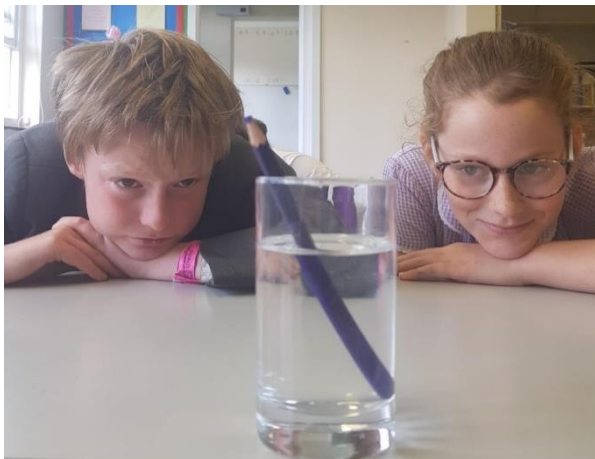


Year 4

In science this week, Year 4 have been investigating materials to find out if they are conductors or insulators of electricity. They have then reported on their findings, explaining why some materials allow electricity to flow through them, and why others don't.

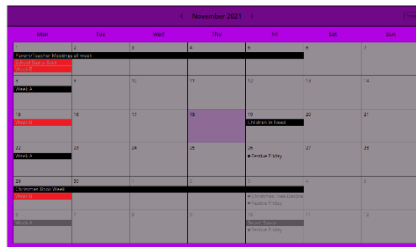
