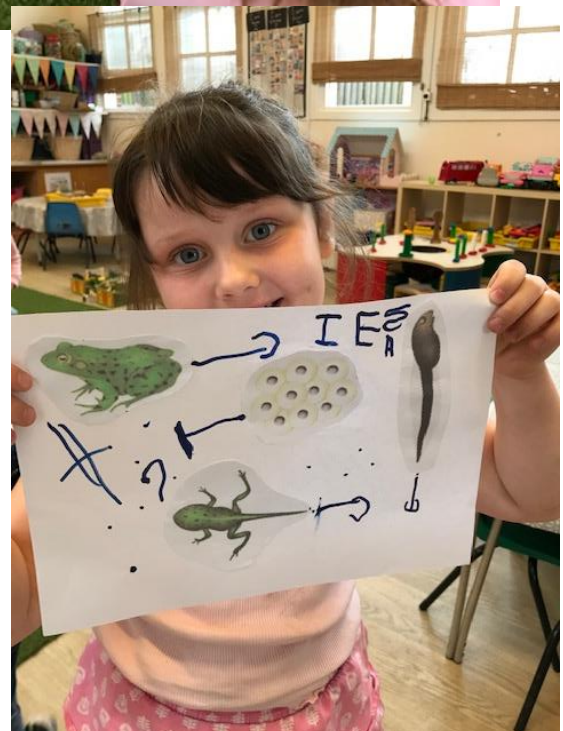

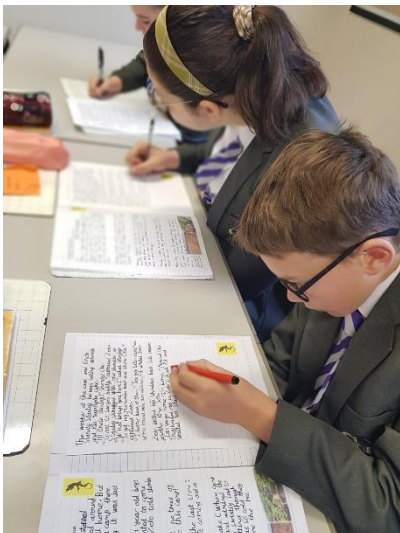
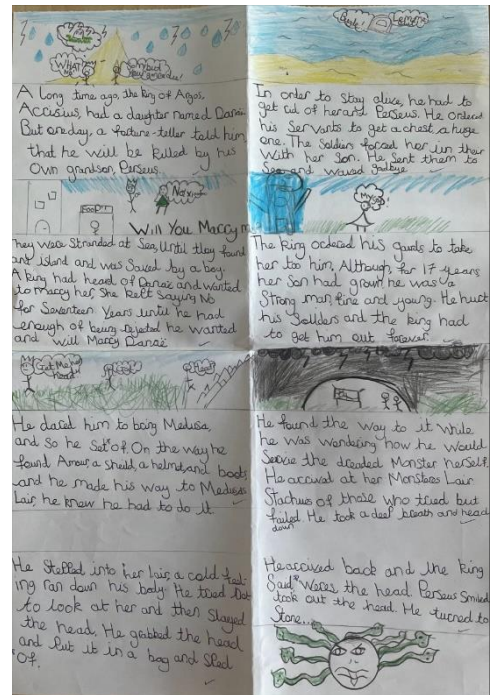


**Year 4**
