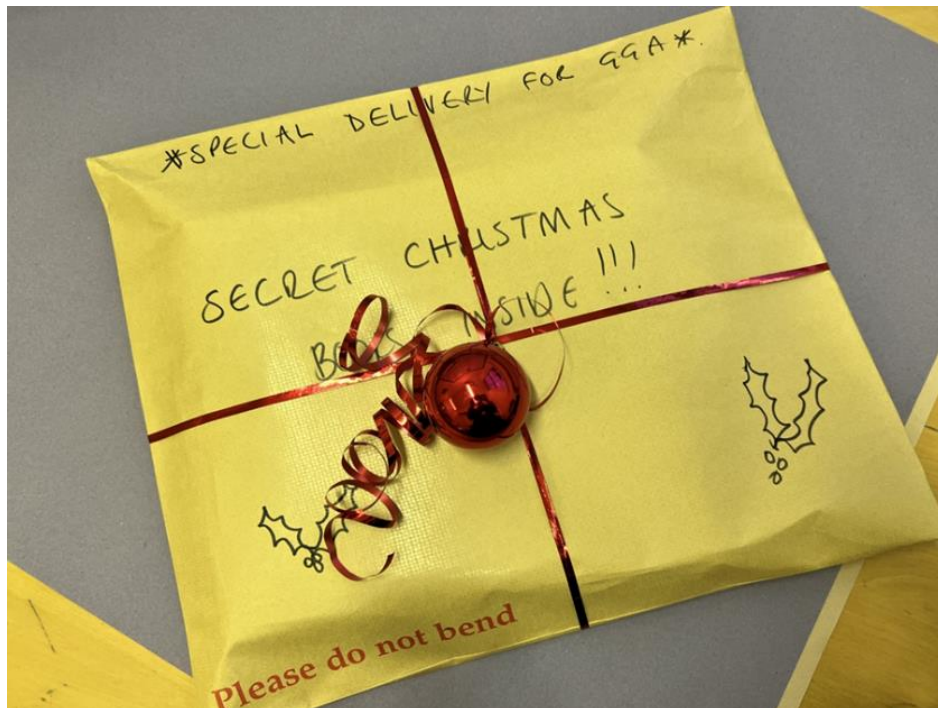

Reception have enjoyed re-enacting 'Incey Wincey Spider' in the water table, spider counting in maths and making firework patterns.

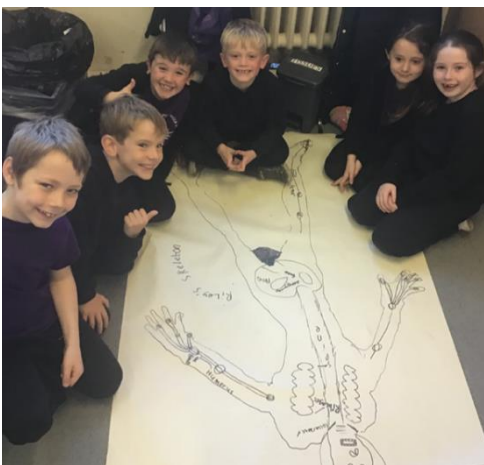


Year 1

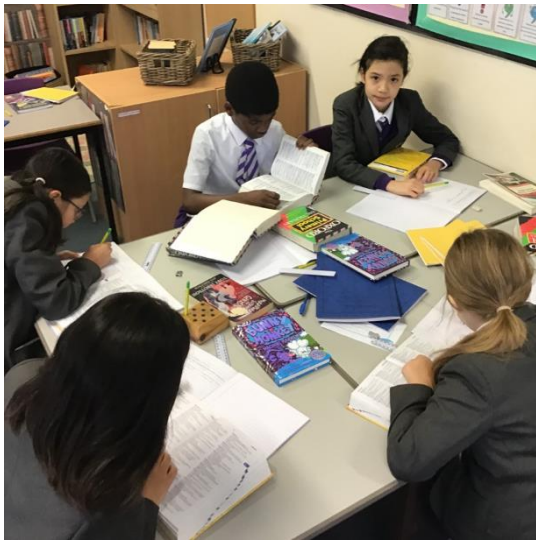


Year 3
