Our new Reception class have settled in this week and we are so proud of how they are getting on.



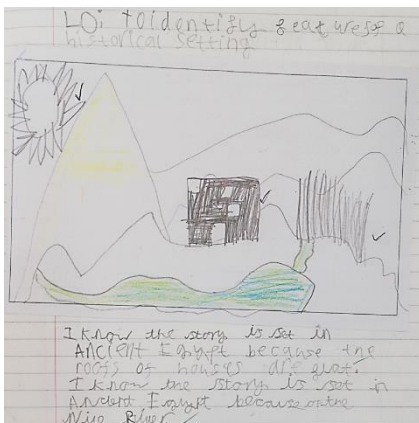
Year 1

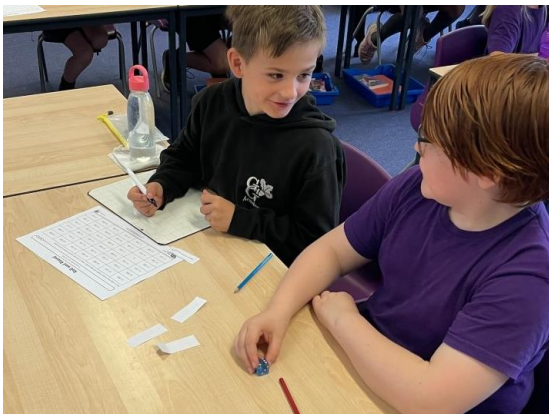


Year 3
