Well done to all our stars of the week this week. We have been so impressed by all the hard work and effort that has gone into achieving this award.

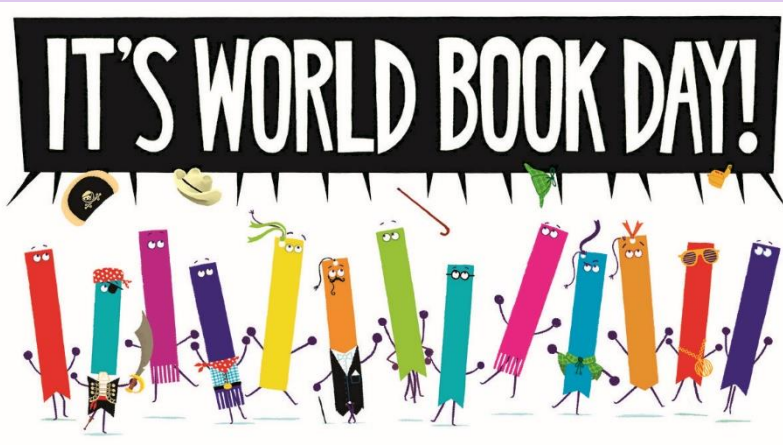

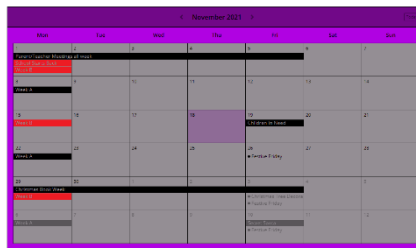
