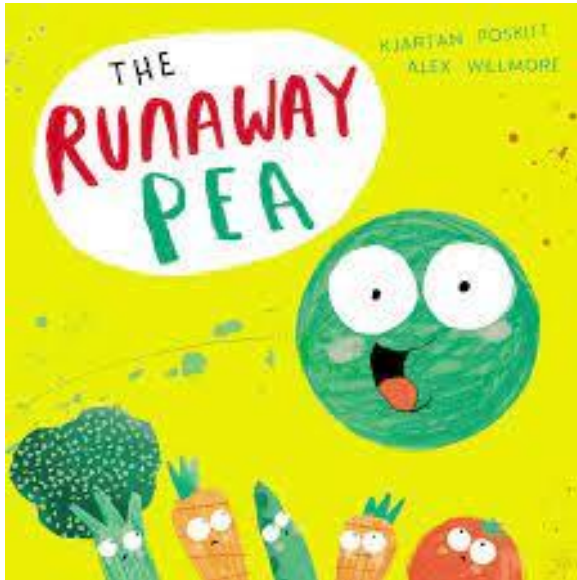
Action Required: Non-Uniform and bring a donation

This week, Year 4 have been learning about the different phases of the moon, and have applied their sketching skills to show this. They also used Oreos to physically create the different phases!



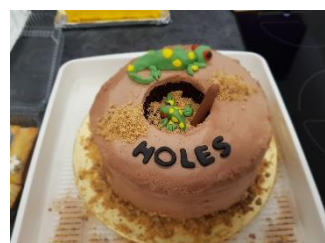
Year 5

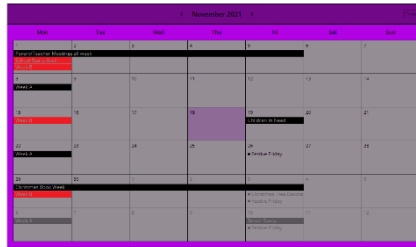
