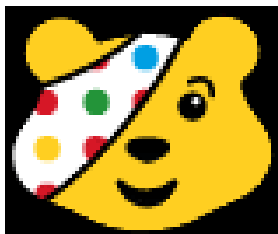

We have collected food for the Harvest Festival



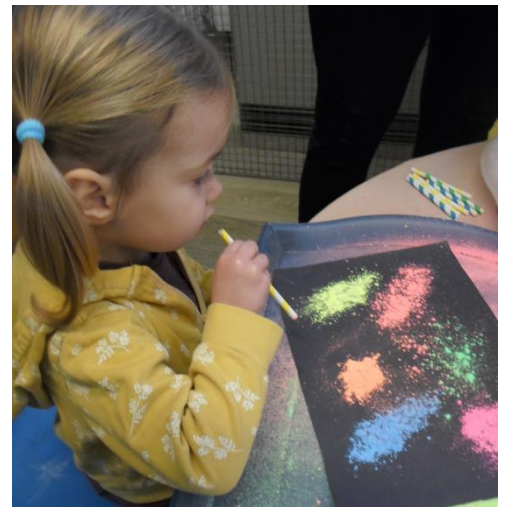
Made diva lamps for Diwali

Reception
