Year 2

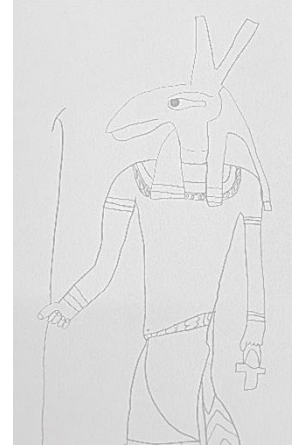


Year 2 have been learning about different sentence types, dividing by sharing equally and have been practising a new fluency game "number bond snap"

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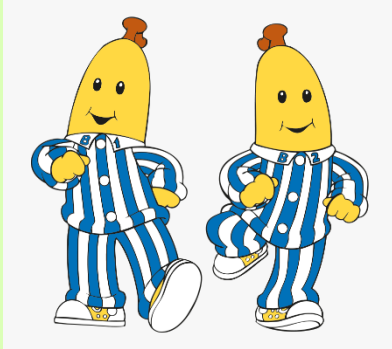
