The spectating area for parents/carers will be marked out clearly, and staff members will be there to guide you.

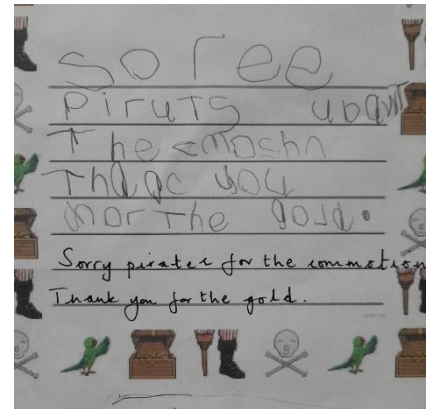
Once Sports Day has finished (3pm), children will be dismissed from their class teacher at the Royal Latin School, and signed out.

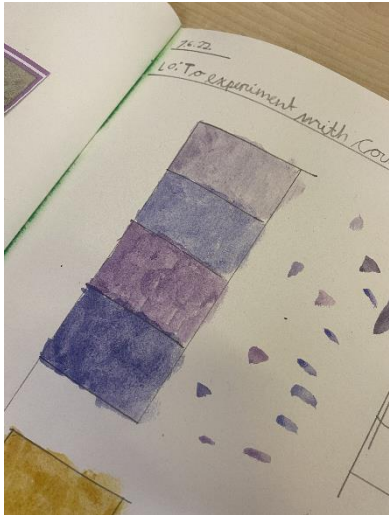
**Year 2**

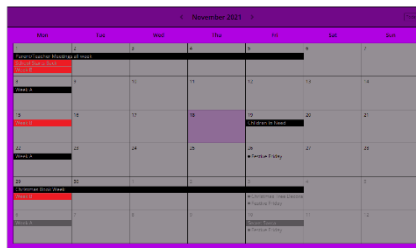
