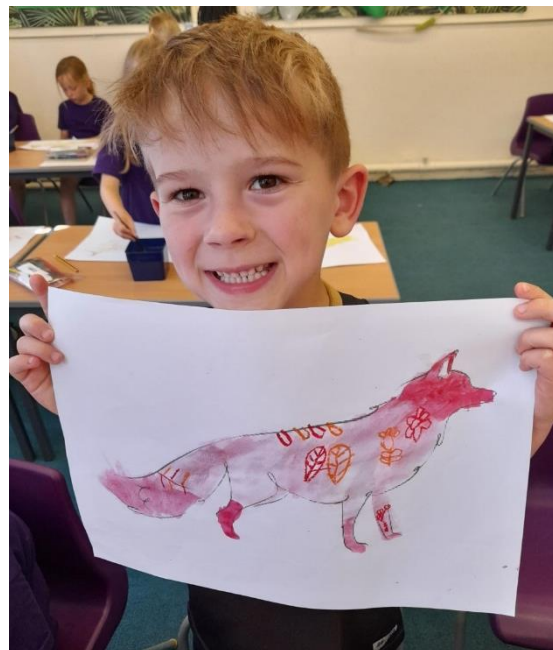


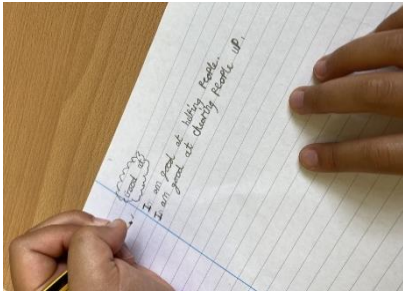
Year 2

Toast before Nutella





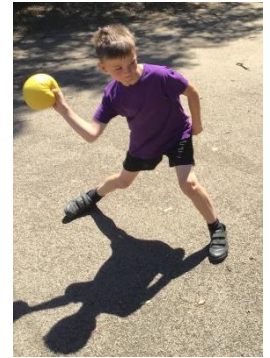
Year 3
