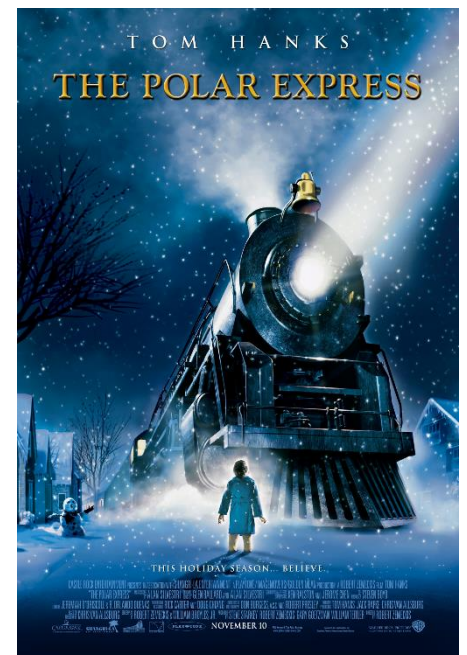
WANTED – Children to join us for the parade

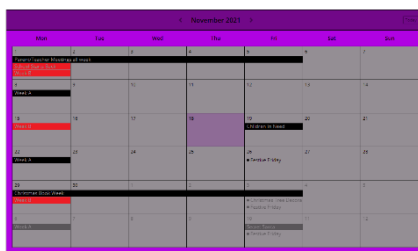
