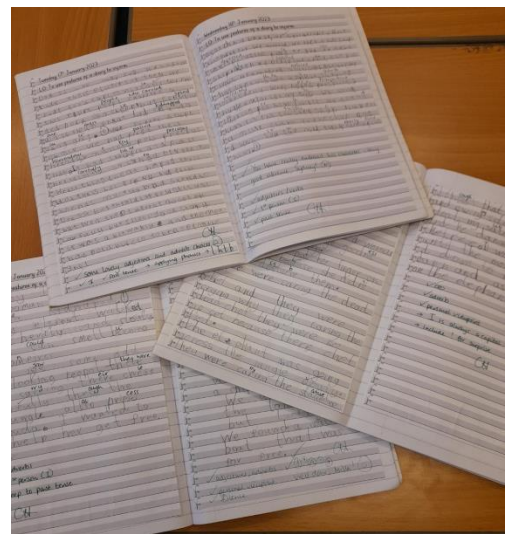


**Year 1**

This week, Year 4 have been looking at fractions. We read the "Hershey's Fractions Book" and then used real chocolate to explore fractions.

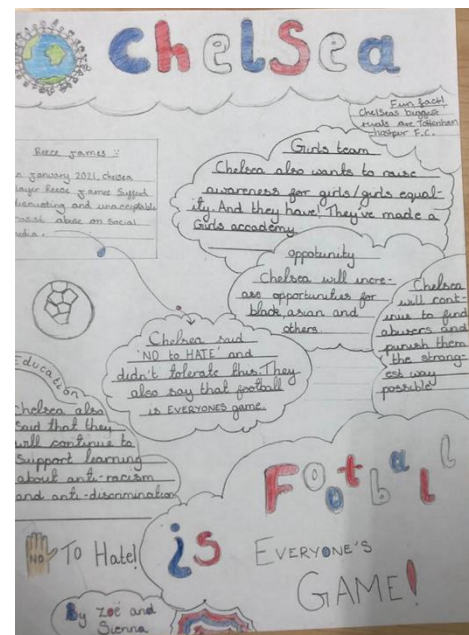


### Year 5

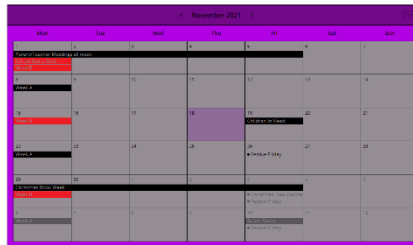
