Parent/Teacher Meetings

We are also pleased to tell you that we have some dates to share with you for a parent/teacher meeting. These will be done either via zoom or telephone and will take about 15 minutes. Parentmail will send you a link during half term and you can follow that link to book an appointment to speak to your child's class teacher.

How will we access the meeting?

You will book a slot via parentmail and will be sent a link to the zoom meeting. As you join this meeting, you will sit in the waiting room and the teacher will call you in when ready. Please make sure you are identifiable by your name on your account. If you would prefer a phone call, then the teacher will call you at the appropriate time.

What can you talk about at this meeting?

Anything to do with your child! You can discuss school or home – anything from how they have transitioned back to full time education, how to encourage them to spend less time on their computer, talk more about what they do at school or their friendship groups. If it matters to you, then it matters to your child's teacher. Their teacher will also let you have the current assessment data for your child and an overview on how they are currently learning. The teachers and you will work collaboratively to create two targets for your child: one academic target and one focusing on a wider outcome.

What happens after the meeting?

Your child's teacher will make brief notes about targets etc. and a photocopy of these will be sent home with your child. There will be action points (for either home or school, or both) that you and/or the teacher have agreed to follow-up on. These will be reviewed at the next meeting, in the Spring term.


