Reception

The children in Reception have been hunting for bugs! They were fascinated with all the woodlice living under the rocks in our garden so we read "I'm a Pill Bug" by Yukihsa Tokuda and found out some interesting facts! We have a tank in our class with woodlice and stick insects. We even have our own wormery, to put the worms we find in, so we can see what they do under the soil.

Year 1

Year 1 have been learning all about Australia and part of this has been learning about aboriginal art. Year 1 have been practising this style of art by using cotton buds to create dots around animal outlines.



Year 2

Year 2 have been learning about plants this half term and what a plant needs to grow. They have grown salad plants (check out the carrots!) and tried to grow cress seeds in different conditions.

Year 3

In RE this week, Year 3 have been learning about Christian stories from the Bible, in particular about Jesus was upset in the Temple. They discussed the emotions and reasons for his actions, linked to the story.



You may need to download some software for this, so please allow some extra time when signing in. This software can be easily deleted once the session is completed.

When you have signed in, on the right hand side of your screen you should have a control panel with different logos.

Every participant is on mute so that there is no echo or background noise. You won't be able to take yourself off mute.

If you click on the speech bubble with a question mark, you will be able to ask any questions you may have. Whilst presenting, a Bushcraft colleague will be keeping an eye on the question box so if there is anything you need to communicate during the presentation, this is how to do it.

Once they have finished the presentation there will be time to ask any questions during a Q&A session. We all look forward to hearing more about the adventures!
