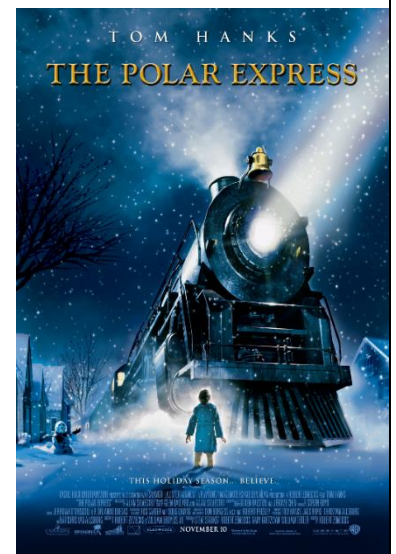
WANTED – Children to join us for the parade

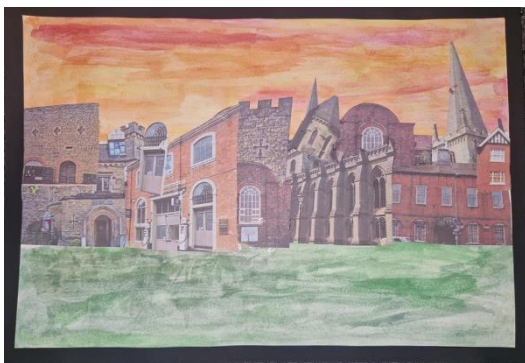
Grenville Christmas Tree Decorating Assembly and Christmas Fair

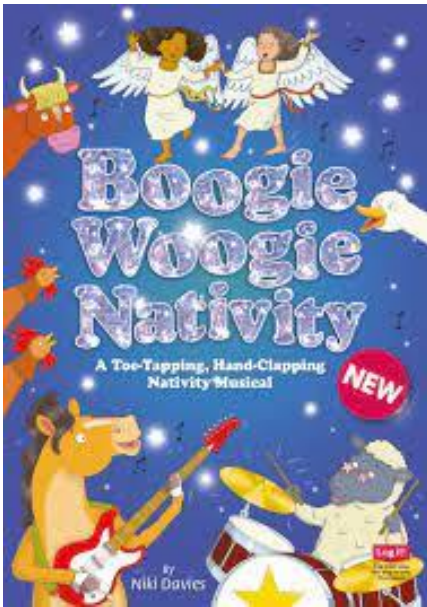

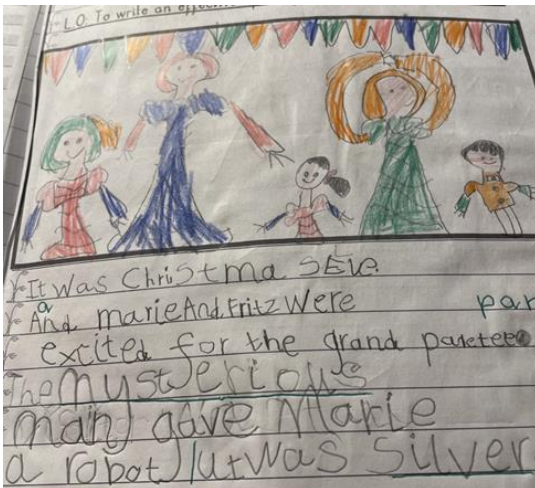
We would appreciate it if ALL the children could come back to school at 4.15pm for the evening performance. They all have a part and it just would not be the same without them!

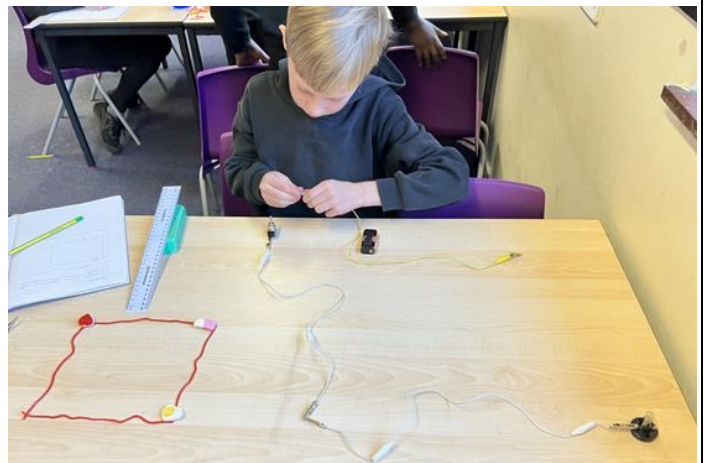
Year 5

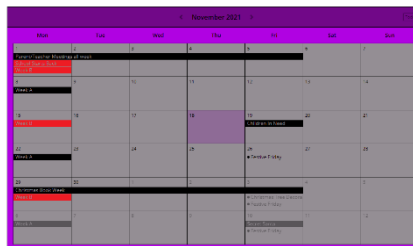
