Good luck – we can't wait to see what will be created...first verse can be found below.

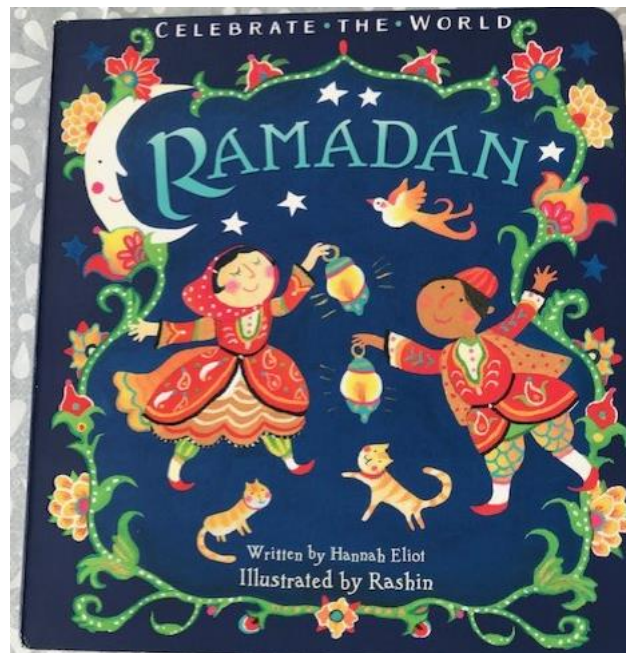

Eid Mubarak!



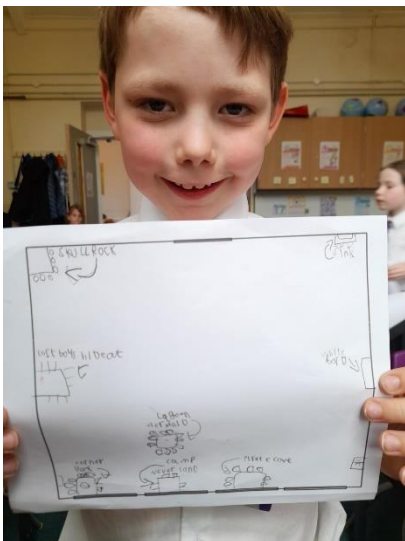
Reception

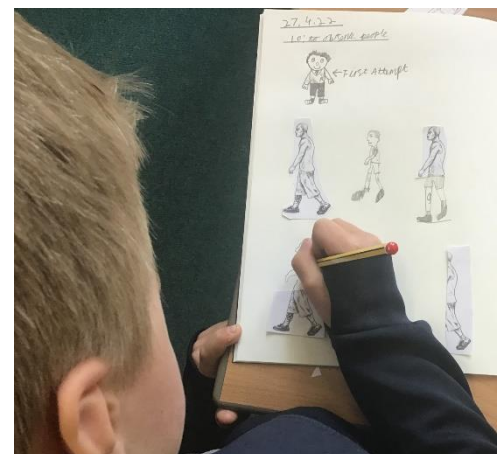
Year 2

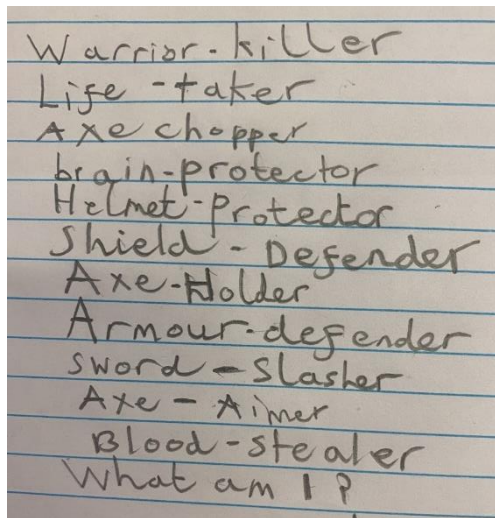

Year 6



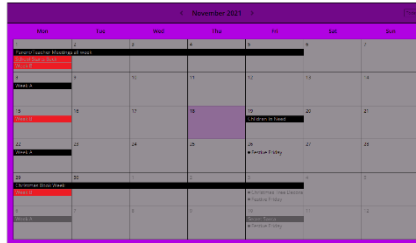
