As it currently stands, we do have some staff striking and as a result, I will be taking the following action:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - For both days, school will be closed to the Reception and Year 1 classes - Children in Years 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 are able to attend as usual. - We will send children in Reception and Year 1 home with some paper based work and ideas for further learning on Tuesday 4th July as the teachers who are striking do not engage in school work during a strike day. <p>I am sorry for any further inconvenience, but am also very aware of the strength of feeling in the profession. This is particularly the case in the light of the government's decision not to provide schools with the funds to cover the proposed salary increase, thus putting extra pressure on already inadequate school budgets.</p>

Year 1

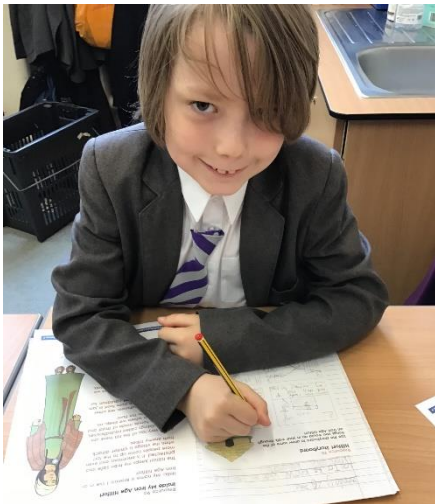

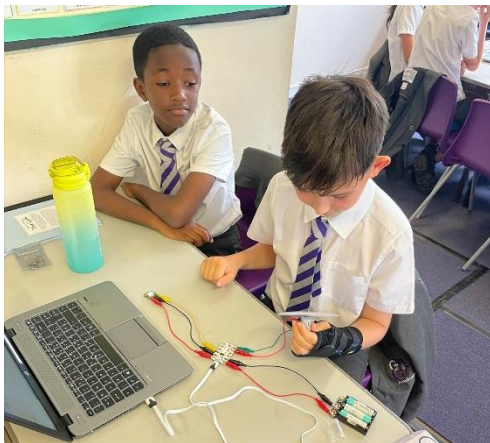


Year 3

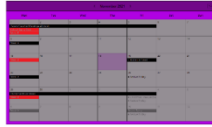
