

## Home-School Behaviour and procedures document.

To keep our children, staff and families as safe as possible, EVERYONE has to play their part. Please read the following protocols and expectations and, where appropriate, share with your children.

### To help keep staff and children as safe as possible, the school /nursery aims to:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection;
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can;
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child, in the best way we can in given circumstances, including their well-being, mental health;
- Contact parents/carers immediately if a child displays any symptoms of COVID-19;
- Inform you if any staff or children in your child's 'bubble' has a confirmed case of COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days.
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in our Behaviour Policy as well as the expectations outlined in this agreement;
- Communicate between home and school through emails, and school website

## PARENTS / CARERS

### To help keep my child and school staff as safe as possible, parents/carers should adhere to the following protocols:

- **My family will follow all government guidance on social distancing and mixing with other people.**
- I will check my child for symptoms each morning, including checking their temperature;
- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school; we will get tested and self-isolate until the results are received. I will let the school know the results immediately;
- If my child shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school **immediately**;
- When dropping my child off and picking them up, we will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules;
- **When dropping off and picking up, I will stick strictly to the school timings for my child;**
- **Only 1 adult will bring my child and pick them up**
- I will teach my child the symptoms of Coronavirus so they can tell an adult if they have them ;
- **My child will bring a water bottle, a rain jacket, a piece of fresh fruit (optional) and nothing else, to school except lunch.**
- I understand that my child will be going outside, whatever the weather;
- I will remind my child about social distancing rules, but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child and other children may not always do this successfully;
- My child will know how to use good respiratory and hand hygiene;
- I will not be allowed into the school grounds, except to collect my child if they are sick, or to go to a pre-arranged doctor's appointment;
- I need to support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment during

this crisis;

- **I will check parentmail regularly for information from school, and act on it if required.**
- I will inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carer and emergency contacts details;
- If my child is deemed unsafe, they will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe.

## **PUPILS**

**In order to help keep themselves and others as safe as possible, pupils should:**

- Follow to the social distancing rules in class and in the playground;
- Move around school as instructed trying to maintaining social distance;
- Tell an adult if I feel unwell;
- Only bring my water bottle and a coat from home
- Not take things home from school;
- Use only my equipment my teachers say I can use
- Only enter and exit the school building from the designated entrance and follow the routines we have set up;
- Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it, bin it, kill it) and avoiding touching my mouth, nose and hands;
- Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser;
- Only enter the toilet if there is no one else in there;
- Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others;
- Not cough, spit at or sneeze towards others;
- Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.
