

Key Vocabulary	
Primary colours	Colours that can't be created by mixing other colours- Red, Blue and Yellow
Secondary colours	Secondary colours include orange, purple, and green, and they're derived from mixing equal amounts of two primary colours at a time
Tint	A tint is where an artist adds a colour to white to create a lighter version of the colour
Shade	Adding black to a colour to make it darker
Colour mixing	Mixing colours together to make new ones
