Slip	Wet clay that you use to join
Joins	The place where something connects
Material	the matter from which a thing is or can be made
Clay	a stiff, sticky fine-grained earth that can be moulded when wet, and is dried and baked to make bricks, pottery, and ceramics
Texture	the feel, appearance, or consistency of a surface or substance
Glaze	Like paint that is added to fired clay to create colour that then needs to be fired
