Scale	The size of an object in relation to another.

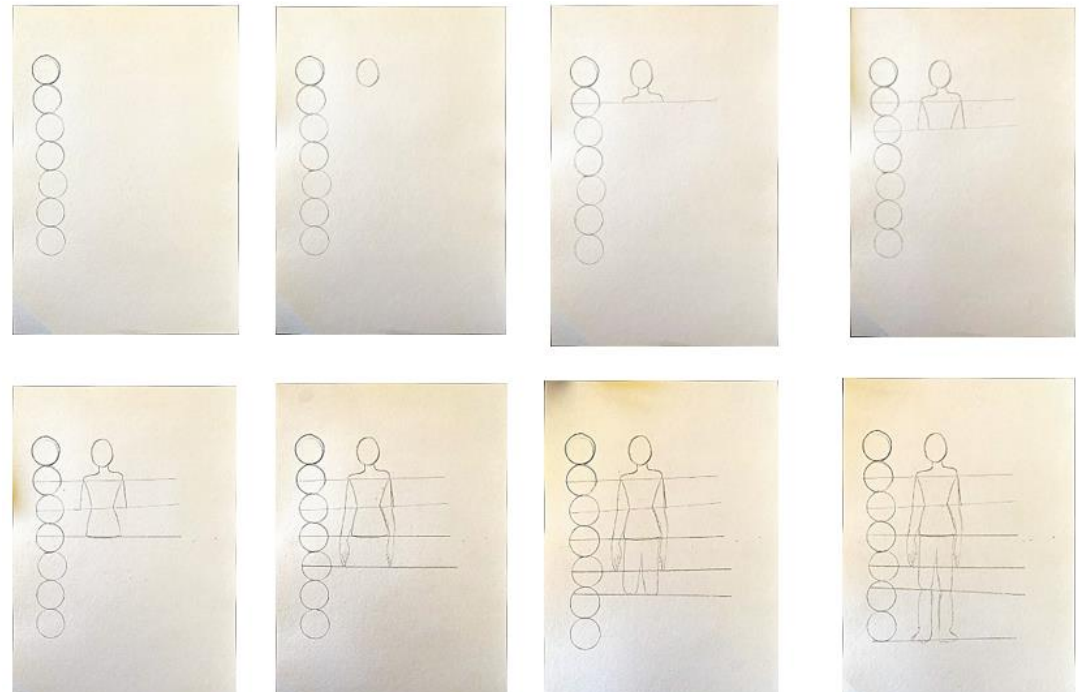
Key Skills
